1. Open your StAAC APP

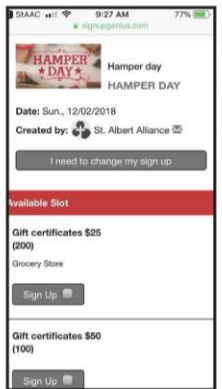


Click on Hamper Day - right next to the "Sunday Tab"

The Spirit was on Him

Isaiah 11:2 ESV

And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.

Isaiah 42:1 ESV

Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my Spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations.

Isaiah 61:1 ESV

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit (reference Matthew 1:18)

The Spirit led him into the wilderness (reference Luke 4:1)

He returned from the wilderness in the power of the Spirit (reference Luke 4:14)

He spoke God's words (reference John 3:34)

He can do nothing apart from the Spirit (reference John 5:19 / John 8:28)

Jesus heals by the spirit (reference Matthew 12:26-28)

It was the Spirit that raised Him from the dead (reference Romans 8:11)

Romans 8:11 ESV

If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

Peter affirms the Spirit was on Jesus (reference Acts 10:38)

Philippians 2:5-8 ESV

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Apollinarianism

The Belief that Jesus had a human body and soul, but Jesus' mind was divine. It contests that Jesus' humanity was incapable on not sinning, therefore needed a Divine mind to overcome this problem. This is heresy.

John 14:12 ESV

BE A TEAM CAPTAIN

1st Build a team. You can invite anyone you want to build a hamper with you (although we get really excited when you invite your un-churched neighbours to join you).

2nd Choose a recipient. Our heart is to bless someone who we know could use some encouragement (tough financial reality, loneliness or the loss of a loved one, are all good options).
