1.	Find your Soul Mate as evidenced by a willingness to 'accept me without trying to change me.'
	Assumption: If it's meant to be, it will be easy.
2.	Fulfill your Sexual Desires without restraint or strings attached.
	Assumption: Cohabitation improves the chances of finding a compatible partner who will meet my needs.
